### **Hope for Christmas**

Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us. (Matthew 1:23)

Peter calls what God the Father gave us, in the person of his Son Jesus, a "living hope." Paul refers to it as a "blessed hope." Last week, I shared with Bobby that it could be "his hope."

As I traveled down Fayetteville Street, I saw a man sitting on the curb. It was quite apparent he was homeless, as well as under the influence of something. The Holy Spirit nudged me to see if he wanted to join me and a group of preachers for breakfast. When I made my way back to invite this young man to come eat with us, he made it clear he was not capable of walking the few hundred feet to the restaurant, even with my help. I sat down on the curb beside him, asked him his name, and how I might help him. He shared his name was Bobby, and he could use a ride to Daymark, a local substance abuse treatment facility.

I went and got my car, helped the young man into the front seat, put a bag containing his belongings in my back seat, and we proceeded to embark on the short drive to the Daymark facility. I wanted to initiate some small talk to put Bobby at ease. "Bobby where you from?" "Rockingham county," he replied. "Do you have any family?" "No," he said. I asked, "No wife or children, mom or dad?" Again, he replied "No." "Well, how old are you, Bobby?" "Thirty," he said. To which I replied, "You have a lot of life in front of you, don't you?" Suddenly, he turned to look at me, and tears began to roll down his face, and he asked, "Then why doesn't it feel like I do?" Brokenness and defeat were streaming down his face, reeking from his skin and clothes. My heart was filled with compassion as I spoke, "Bobby, Satan is trying to destroy you. He hates God, and because God loves you, he wants to see you destroyed. He is using drugs and alcohol and people to kill you. But Bobby, Jesus loves you. He loves you so much He came to Earth and gave His life so you could have hope. A hope for the future and a hope for today." As Bobby looked at me, you could tell he was trying to process the words coming from my lips, so I asked him if anyone had ever shared that with him. Again,




