

PASTOR JEFF JOYCE

As I write this article for the newsletter, I am preparing to leave for a Leadership Lab sponsored by the North American Mission Board in Atlanta, Georgia. It has been on my calendar for several months, and many of my fellow AMSs have told me how good and profitable the sessions will be. I believe them and am looking forward to a couple of days of encouragement, instruction, and fellowship. All that being said, and realizing I need to leave for Atlanta in just a few hours, I have yet to pack the first thing for this trip. I don't even have the route I'll travel pulled up on GPS. As a matter of fact, I'm not sure how I will be able to accomplish some of the tasks I need to get done before I leave and still be able to leave on time. Some of you are reading this and thinking, "That's poor planning Jeff. How can you be so irresponsible?" You know you may be right.

If you would, allow me to play on my lack of preparedness and relate it to another future event many of us are anticipating. Recently, I passed a church sign that said, "Jesus is returning, are you ready?", and it caused me to ponder that question. Most of you reading this article are born again children of God who believe that one day Christ will return and take his bride home to Heaven. You believe it could happen any moment, in the "twinkling of an eye", and yet, are you ready? I'm not necessarily referring to the status of your relationship with Christ; no, you can tell me the day and time you received Christ as your Savior, and I believe you. My question is more addressing your anticipation for the event. Is this a trip you are eagerly anticipating - one that you are making sure others know you are taking? We know it's going to be an amazing trip, and anyone can go with us, but are we encouraging others to join us?

As I read through the New Testament, I keep coming across comments by several of the writers sharing their longing for the return of Christ, and how this longing is affecting their daily lives and activities. I wonder if Christ's return is having an effect on our comings and goings day in and day out. The imminent return of Christ and these writers' response to it seems to fuel their Christian walk.

- Listen to James, "Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain. Be ye also patient; stablish your hearts: for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh. Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest ye be condemned: behold, the judge standeth before the door." James 5:7-9.
- Peter wrote, "But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer." 1 Peter 4:7.
- John shares, "The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John" Revelation 1:1.
- Paul, on several occasions shares: "Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, right-eously, and godly, in this present world; Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our
