November 2, 2025, was the **Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church**. Believers around the world are challenged to pray for their 380 million, or 1 out of 7, Christian brothers and sisters facing persecution and discrimination because of their faith. The levels of persecution continue to rise and have almost doubled in the last 30 years.

Persecution may look like families being separated or ostracized by their communities. Christians may face discrimination in the workplace or in the education system. They could lose their jobs or become targets of extremists. Many have to flee their homes, face imprisonment, torture or even death.

Let us follow Paul's admonition to us in Ephesians 6:18-20, "And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and **always keep on praying for all the Lord's people**. Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should."

- Ask God to comfort and strengthen persecuted believers who "are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed" (2 Corinthians 4:4-9)
- Pray for the church to be confident in Christ's ultimate victory on the cross remembering John 16:33 "In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world."
- Pray God will give persecuted believers the perspective and grace to "count it all joy" and trust "that the testing of their faith produces steadfastness" (James 1:2-3)
- Pray for believers around the world who endure persecution to continue speaking God's word "with all boldness" (Acts 4:29). Ask God to use their witness to draw many people to himself.


