

Spring has sprung! 2025 seems to be zooming by so quickly. It makes me think of Psalm 20:12, "Teach us the brevity of life, so that we may grow in wisdom", and then Proverbs 9:10, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom..." RBA is encouraging each of our association churches to take part in a prayer effort scheduled around Holy Week, April13-20. Fear of the Lord Prayer guides are being made available in print or digitally to churches to share with their membership. April 20, Easter Sunday, is right around the corner, and many of you have activities planned to reach out to the people your community. Erica and I will be praying with you that these events are successful in sharing the blessed hope the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ brings to every individual who will personally receive it.


